Instruction Leaflet

Expedition Framed Back Carrier



Suitable for babies from 6 months up to 18 kg
Complies with BS EN 13209 - 1 : 2004

1. Open the zipped compartment at the back of the carrier and push the stand down until you hear a 'click'.

2. Now zip up the compartment. This space can be used as a storage pocket.

3. Before placing your child in the carrier adjust the length of the belt according to the baby's height. The seat needs to be positioned higher for small babies and lower for taller babies.

4. Before putting your child in the carrier, adjust the height of the back shoulder belt according to the height of the adult.

You can choose from one of the four height settings on the back of the carrier and adjust the shoulder belt until you feel it is in a comfortable position.

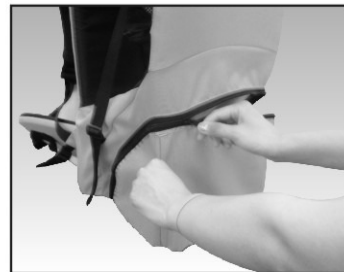
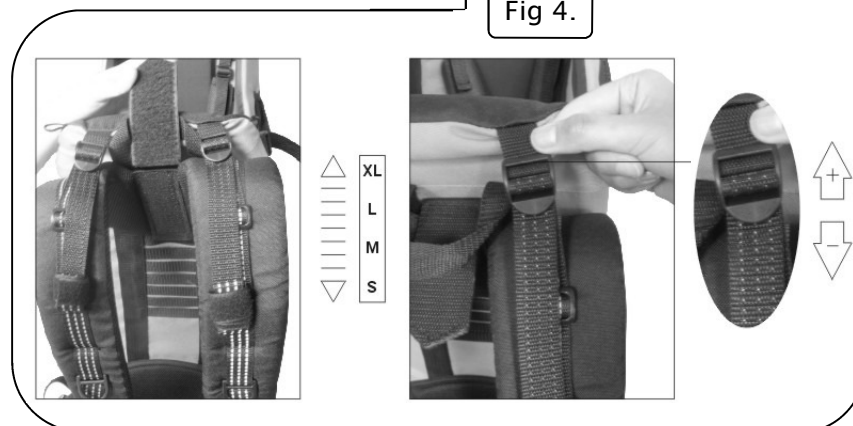

5. To fasten the harness
 Insert the fastener securely into the clasp.
 Adjust the shoulder straps with the sliders (A). Adjust the waist straps by pulling the free ends of the straps.

To unfasten the harness
 Squeeze the prongs together to release the harness. Your child should always be harnessed in and should never be left alone even if for a short time.

6. Put the carrier on your back. Fasten the hip belt buckle so it fits comfortable on your hips. Now fasten the chest strap across your chest and adjust so that the shoulder straps sit comfortably in place.

7. **Accessories:** Canopy, weathershield, mesh pocket.

- Fit the canopy as showing on the photo.
 Now connect the hook to the carrier.

Attention: Ensure the hook has been securely attached to the carrier.

- Place the weathershield over the canopy and connect the hook to the carrier.
- Two mesh pockets are provided on the side of the carrier to provide useful storage space for baby's essentials whilst out and about.

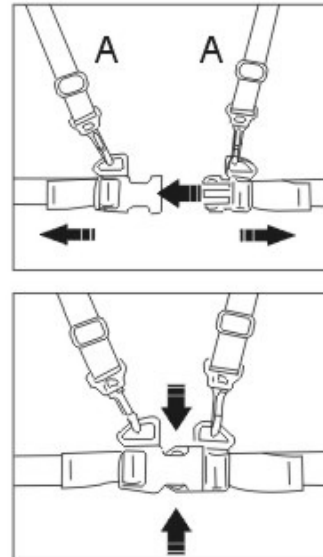
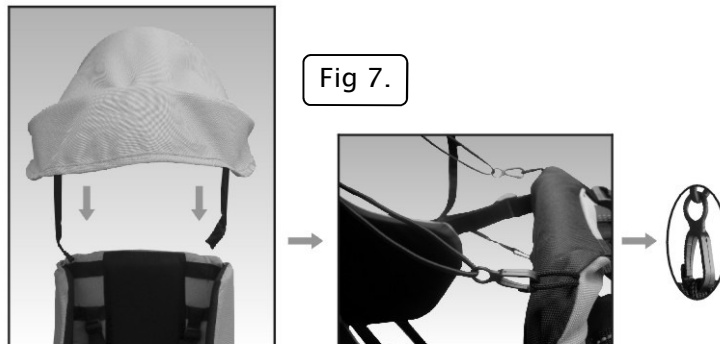

General Care:

- The correct use and maintenance of this baby carrier is essential.
- In some climates mould and mildew can affect the fabric and raincover. To avoid this, do not fold the baby carrier when it is wet. Leave it open in a ventilated area until completely dry.
- Always store the baby carrier in a dry place.
- When storing the baby carrier in the car never place other items on top of it.

Cleaning:

- Fabric covers and accessories may be spot washed using mild detergent and warm water. Rinse and leave to dry in a ventilated area away from direct sunlight.
- Avoid leaving your baby carrier in direct sunlight for prolonged periods of time as this may cause fabrics to fade.
- Do not dry clean, machine wash or tumble dry.
- Metal parts may be cleaned with a damp cloth. Always wipe dry. Clean plastic parts with a mild soap and water solution, rinse and wipe dry.

Maintenance:

- Check that nothing is loose or broken and that no sharp edges have been exposed. Inspect all joints and the harness. Replace any damaged parts immediately.
- Only use replacement parts and accessories that have been obtained from the manufacturer or distributor. Failure to do this may invalidate your warranty.

Intended Use:

- The baby carrier is designed for use in leisure activities like walking but not for sporting activities such as cycling and running.

Accessories: Canopy, weathershield, mesh pocket.

- Fit the canopy as showing on the photo. Now connect the hook to the carrier.

Attention: Ensure the hook has been securely attached to the carrier.

- Place the weathershield over the canopy and connect the hook to the carrier.
- Two mesh pockets are provided on the side of the carrier to provide useful storage space for baby's essentials whilst out and about.

SAFETY WARNINGS:

- **WARNING:** Do not leave the child unattended in this carrier!
- **WARNING -** Do not use until the child can sit unaided.
- **WARNING -** When the child is in the carrier, it could be in a position higher than the carer. Care should therefore be taken to be aware of hazards; e.g. door frames, low branches of trees etc.
- **WARNING -** When using the carrier the carer shall be aware of the following:
 - the carer's balance may be adversely affected due to the movement of the child and also the carer;
 - the carer will need to take great care when bending or leaning forward;
 - the carrier is suitable for use when undertaking leisure activities but not for sports activities.
 - care shall be taken when putting on or removing the carrier.
- Suitable from 6 months (provided the baby can sit unaided) up to 18 kg.
- It may be unsafe to use accessories other than those approved by the manufacturer or distributor.
- The child's harness should always be securely fastened and adjusted in accordance with the instructions provided.
- Care should be taken to avoid injury to the child's feet when the carrier is on or near the floor.
- Be aware that the child in the carrier may suffer from the effect of the weather and temperature before you do.
- The child in the carrier can become tired and it is recommended to make frequent breaks.
